The following is a message from Marcia Huehnerfuss, a member of the North Central Wi chapter: *On April 7 last year one of our German Shorthairs was killed by wolves. You may have read the story Scott Daenicke put in the NAVHDA magazine in July. With the wolves increasing our dogs are no longer safe hunting in Wi. On April 14 there will public meetings held in each county. The locations are listed on the DNR web site under conservation congress meetings. There will be two questions up for vote. Question 17: Protection of Private Property on Public Land. Currently a landowner, lessee or occupant of private property may shoot and kill any gray wolf that is in the act of killing, wounding or biting a domestic animal. Do you support the department introducing administrative rule changes that would allow a person to protect their personal property on public land as they are currently allowed to do on private land? Question 29: Do you favor the DNR, WI Conservation Congress and the Wi legislature develop a season framework and harvest goals to maintain the wolf population within management objectives? Please contact all of your members and tell them about these meetings. I don't want anybody else go through what happened to us. Also our chapter is now a member of the Wi Wolf Stakeholders Board.
